I acknowledge that this release is being relied upon by WCP to permit transportation of my dog(s) to and from a scheduled location, such as a veterinary facility, groomer, dog daycare, or group outing, etc. I accept any and all conditions and policies set forth associated with the activities and I hereby agree to comply with them. WCP may, at any time, refuse a dog transportation if the dog exhibits behavior that could be harmful to the dog, other dogs, or staff, such as: aggression or uncooperative behavior, high anxiety, refusal of dog to load into vehicle, or a condition or behavior rendering the dog generally not fit for transportation. We will not transport any pet that requires a muzzle or other restrictive device. I accept that WCP is not in any way responsible for any injury or illness while under their care. I will not hold WCP liable, financially, or legally, for any physical, mental, or health issues that arise during or as a result of my dog's transport.
